Apart from the various accounts the Foundation offers there are other matters that we may be able to assist your church with, like how to setup a set of accounts in MYOB to allow your church to keep good records of their financial position. This could help with any churches that require their accounts to be audited and also with presenting the accounts to your church members. Wei is our Financial Controller and he can assist in these matters. A phone call for the initial contact and we can get things started.

We can also assist your church by acting as trustees for your property. Under the Stewards Foundation Act the Foundation appoints a Management Committee, who can be nominated by the church, and usually would consist of Deacons and some Elders. The Foundation does not interfere with the day to day running of the church, as we believe that is the responsibility of the Elders and the church. We assist in the management of the property and how to keep your property in good order.



We also administer a Disaster Relief Funds for disasters within Australia.

This would be like Floods, fires,

drought etc. Where possible we use the local church in the area to help distribute funds to those in need and also form a link with the church and the persons affected by the disaster.
